Position Summary

Reports to the CFO/COO. Primary responsibilities include diving the mobile health unit to dedicated locations in Indiana and performing basic medical assistant work including point of care testing, height, weight and other basic vitals. Organization will provide training for health care skills.

Duties and Responsibilities Include:

- Drive Mobile Unit
- Ensure mobile unit receives maintenance as required.
- Greet clients as they enter the family planning clinic and determining each client's needs.

• Responsible for following medical records policies and procedures and creating a medical record for each new client.

• Responsible and accountable for maintaining all clinic medical records according to organizational policies and Health Information Portability and Accountability Act

• Reviews client charts, registers client for clinic visit, obtains and records client's weight and

vital signs, takes patient history, obtains urine samples, and assesses reason(s) for client visit. • Communicates laboratory results to the Advanced Practice Nurse; provides information to the client and coordinates follow-up visits as needed.

• Cleans and prepares exam room/mobile unit for each client visit.

Working Conditions

Daily tasks include a mixture of standing, sitting, driving, and walking. Hand-eye coordination with significant manual dexterity and frequent repetitive hand motions. Reaching above the head and lifting up to 25-pound items occurs occasionally. Visual and hearing acuity to perform essential responsibilities. Looking at computer screens or small items is common.
